WEEK 5

God loves us and gives us good surprises. Abraham and Sarah were surprised at the birth of their son, Isaac. They thanked God for good surprises. **Ask: What was Abraham and Sarah's surprise?**

DO THIS



MEAL TIME

Before supper, go around the table and encourage everyone to share something that they can thank God for. Remind your preschooler that God loves us and gives us what we need.

PLAY TIME

Grab your favorite ball and sit across the room or yard from your preschooler. Take turns rolling or bouncing the ball back and forth. Each time you pass the ball, practice saying this month's Bible verse, "We Trust God."



OUTSIDE TIME

Grab some sidewalk chalk and have fun decorating your sidewalk or driveway with pictures of all the things that God provides for us (ex: family, sunshine, food, etc). Remind your preschooler that God loves us and gives us what we need.



OUTSIDE TIME

Play a game of follow the leader with your preschooler. Have your child follow you and then you follow your child. When you're finished, remind him/her that God loves us and helps us follow Him.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up together and read the story of Abraham from your favorite kids Bible or on the Bible app for kids (God's Amazing Promise).
