Reading Plan, based on Scriptures used in series messages

January 2018

Week 1: Called to Mission

- Matthew 28:16-20
- Psalm 67
- Romans 10:14-15
- Romans 15:20-21

Our limitless God has invited us into his limitless mission, with limitless potential and possibility! As you read and pray through these Scripture passages this week, reflect on your personal, God-given, Christ-enabled, Holy Spirit-empowered calling to spread the gospel, to make disciples, no matter your station, location, or vocation. You play a significant part in the eternal purpose of God to glorify his name and display his love, by participating in God's bigpicture plan to save and love people all over the world, including right where you are!

Week 2: Called to Service

• 2 Corinthians 5:11-21

We who follow Jesus share a calling to be "on mission" for God in a certain way, at a certain time, among a certain people, in a certain location, or through a certain vocation. This week, in light of our amazing opportunity to partner with Builders for Christ on our summer building project, as you read and pray through this Scripture passage, prayerfully consider your personal faithfulness to God's call on your life. You will make a difference in the world through Spirit-led, Word-driven, prayer-focused dedication to living out your unique, individual, God-given desires, gifts, abilities, and opportunities.

Week 3: Called to Share

- Matthew 5:13-16
- Matthew 13:31-33
- Matthew 16:17-19
- Acts 1:8

When you share your story of salvation and transformation through Jesus, you shine! You may not realize it, but when you proclaim the gospel in this way, you are evangelizing! Evangelism doesn't have to be scary; it is simply sharing the good news of who Jesus is and what he has done for you and all people. As we share the gospel message in language people can relate to, the Holy Spirit provides all the power we need, and the Holy Spirit does the work of turning a person's heart and mind toward Christ. As you read and pray through these Scriptures passages this week, reflect on your story and how it is connected to the gospel of Jesus. Then, prayerfully ask God to guide you into opportunities to share your story with others who will be able to see the light and life in it!
