## **BIBLE STORY**

**LUKE 17:11-19** 

## SAY THIS

"DON'T BE A TURKEY JUST SAY THANKS"





Put a pumpkin and a marker in the middle of your table. Throughout the month, take turns writing or drawing pictures of things your family is thankful for. See if you can fill your pumpkin with thanks by the end of the month. Don't be a turkey, just say thanks!



Grab a jump rope, some shoelaces, or a long string to play a fun game to help your child learn this month's Bible verse! Lay the rope or shoelace in the middle of your living room. Then have your child walk across it, like walking on a tight rope. Each time they take a step, have them say one word of the Bible verse, "It is good to give thanks to God." Switch it up by having them walk backwards or jump back and forth over the rope.



Using playdoh, you and your child can create models of things you are thankful for. Tell Jesus thank-you for each of the things you make.



Go to the "JWKids Prek-K/Kindergarten" page http://jacobswellchurch.church/jwkids/pre-k-kindergarten and watch this month's new story with Ms. Nicole. Remind your child of all the good things Jesus gives us. Don't be a turkey, just say thanks!



Pray this prayer together at bedtime and invite your child to repeat each sentence after you: Thank you, God, for this day. Thank you, God, for my family. Thank you, God, for my friends. Thank you, God, for making me. Thank you, God, for [name additional things you are thankful for]. Amen.



As you're driving around, play this month's worship song, "Don't be a Turkey, Just Say Thanks" by Yancy and have fun singing and worshiping together. Tell Jesus thank you for the good things He gives us.
